Backyard Bible Clubs - This is a wonderful way to make an eternal difference in children's lives. We have 5 Backyard Bible Club locations presently. We are planning to add another 3 - 5. All of them will be during one of the 4 full weeks in July (5-31). Each BBC will be from

6:00 – 8:30 pm on M, T ,R ,and F.

Our needs are:

- People who are willing to open up their backyards to neighborhood children for a week. If you host a BBC then the curriculum is already set and all of the supplies are taken care of.
- People to work at the clubs for 4 evenings
- People to buy supplies
- People to transport materials on a Friday evening or Saturday day from one BBC to the next.
- People to organize and replenish supplies on Saturdays between BBC's.

Breakfast for teachers at Norwood Elementary School -1909 Merchants Drive, 37912 Monday, August 10 at 7:30 am

We will be showing our appreciation for the dedication, hard work and love that they give to their students every day. Please join us if you would like to prepare food, buy needed items such as paper products, or if you have time to help serve these wonderful people at Norwood Elementary.

Car Care - Saturdays, June 6 & July 25 - We will be servicing cars from 11:00 am-3:00 pm with set up from 10:00-11:00 am and clean up from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The clinic will take place at the Round Building, with a car wash station at the Flavorich Building. The clinic will offer free oil changes, fluid level checks, and "light" vehicle inspections.

Volunteers are needed for the following areas:

- Mechanics (those skilled in working "under the hood")
- Triage workers (to assess needs of the cars and help direct the flow of cars)
- Sign-in workers (to greet people, fill out releases, and direct flow of people)
- Hospitality workers (to assist with childcare and refreshments in the Round Building)
- Car Washers
- Parking attendants to direct cars from oil change to car wash areas
- People to deliver flyers to area neighborhoods prior to the car care clinic
- Workers should wear "work" style clothing for appropriate areas.

Care Packages for Marines in Iraq - Please bring items and place them in the box next to the water fountains in the lobby labeled "Marines" by Friday, May 29. Their needs are: Soap (such as Irish Spring, Dial & Lever 2000), Q-Tips, Baby wipes, finger nail clippers, foot powder, body powder, shaving cream, Germ X, Lysol wipes, nonperishable snack foods, mouthwash, packs of tuna, toothpaste, deodorant, Neosporin, band aids & Post It Notes.
